MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The father of Damarion M., Zaybreon M., Kendra R., and Emmalyah R. appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Ellsworth, *Mallonee, J.*) terminating his parental rights to the children. Contrary to the father's contentions, there is sufficient evidence in the record to support the court's findings, by clear and convincing evidence, of at least one ground of parental unfitness and that termination is in the best interests of the children. *See* 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (2015); *In re M.S.*, 2014 ME 54, ¶¶ 13, 15, 90 A.3d 443.
