MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of A.F. appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Biddeford, Foster, J.) terminating her parental rights and responsibilities to her children, A.F. and K.T. The trial court found that the mother met three statutory grounds of unfitness, and that termination was in the best interest of the children. See 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1) (2015). Because the mother does not challenge two of the findings of unfitness nor the finding of best interest on appeal, and because the one ground that she does challenge is supported by clear and convincing evidence in the record, we affirm.
