MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Walter R. Bachelder and Bachelder's Construction, Inc. (collectively, Bachelder) appeal from a judgment of the Superior Court (Kennebec County, *Mullen, J.*) denying Bachelder's motion to set aside a default judgment on the complaint of The Maine Event LLC for foreclosure on a commercial loan. Contrary to Bachelder's contentions, the court did not abuse its discretion by declining to set aside the default judgment based on Bachelder's failure to timely answer the complaint. *See* M.R. Civ. P. 5(f), 8, 10, 11, 55(b)(2), (c), 60(b)(1), (6); *Ezell v. Lawless*, 2008 ME 139, ¶¶ 19, 22, 28-29, 955 A.2d 202.
