MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Michelle L. Riordan appeals from a judgment of conviction for operating under the influence (Class D), 29-A M.R.S. § 2411(1-A)(A) (2015), entered by the trial court (Franklin County, *Stokes, J.*) after a jury trial. Contrary to Riordan's contentions, the evidence in the record was sufficient for the jury to find each element of the charge beyond a reasonable doubt. *See State v. Herzog*, 2012 ME 73, ¶ 13, 44 A.3d 307.
