MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The father of Jada Y. appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Portland, *Powers, J.*) finding that he placed the child in circumstances of jeopardy. *See* 22 M.R.S. § 4035 (2015). Contrary to the father's assertions, the evidence was sufficient for the court to find by a preponderance of the evidence that the child was in circumstances of jeopardy to her health and welfare. *See* 22 M.R.S. § 4035; *In re Z.S.*, 2015 ME 110, ¶ 6, 121 A.3d 1286.
