MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Donald Cain appeals from a judgment of divorce from Lisa A. (Cain) Harvey entered in the District Court (Houlton, *O'Mara, J.*). Because Cain did not provide us with an adequate record for review, *see Kilton v. Kilton*, 2016 ME 63, ¶ 5, --- A.3d ---, we must assume that competent record evidence supports the court's implicit factual finding that Harvey resided in good faith in Maine for at least six months before filing her complaint for divorce, *see Springer v. Springer*, 2009 ME 118, ¶ 8, 984 A.2d 828; *see also* M.R. App. P. 5(a), (b)(2), and the court therefore had subject matter jurisdiction over this action pursuant to 19-A M.R.S. § 901(1)(A) (2015).
