MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Donna M. Pagnani appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Augusta, *Nale, J.*) adjudicating that she committed the civil traffic infraction of speeding. *See* 29-A M.R.S. § 2073(3) (2016). Contrary to Pagnani's contentions, viewing the evidence in the light most favorable to the State, the record contains sufficient evidence to support the court's adjudication, by a preponderance of the evidence, that she committed the traffic offense of speeding. *See* 29-A M.R.S. §§ 103(4), 2073(3), 2075(4)(A) (2016); M.R. Civ. P. 80F(j); *State v. Jeskey*, 2016 ME 134, ¶ 2, 146 A.3d 127.
