MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Debra A. Lewis appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Waterville, *Stanfill*, *J*.) divorcing the parties and equitably distributing their marital property.

Contrary to Debra's contentions, the court did not abuse its discretion in considering the relevant statutory factors and distributing the parties' marital property and debts. See 19-A M.R.S. § 953(1) (2016); Lewin v. Skehan, 2012 ME 31, \P 25, 39 A.3d 58; Kruy v. Kruy, 2002 ME 14, \P 5, 789 A.2d 99 ("A failure to consider all factors in distributing the marital property constitutes an abuse of discretion."); Boyd v. Boyd, 421 A.2d 1356, 1359 (Me. 1980).
