MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Christie Darcy appeals from a judgment of the Superior Court (Cumberland County, *Warren, J.*) dismissing for insufficient service of process her sex-discrimination complaint against Maine Medical Center (MMC). Contrary to Darcy's contentions, the court did not abuse its discretion when it determined that Darcy had failed to establish excusable neglect for her tardy service of MMC, and thus the court did not err in concluding that Darcy was not entitled to an enlargement of time pursuant to M.R. Civ. P. 6(b). *See* M.R. Civ. P. 6(b)(2); *Maguire Constr., Inc. v. Forster*, 2006 ME 112, ¶ 8, 905 A.2d 813; *Gregory v. City of Calais*, 2001 ME 82, ¶¶ 6-9, 771 A.2d 383.
