MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Mark J. Theriault appeals from a judgment of the trial court (Aroostook County, *Stewart, J.*) denying his motions to modify the conditions of his probation. Because Theriault has not provided a transcript of the hearing on the motions as required by M.R. App. P. 5(a), (b)(1)(A), we “assume that the transcript would support the trial court’s findings of fact and its rulings on evidence and procedure.” *State v. Hughes*, 2004 ME 141, ¶ 7, 863 A.2d 266 (quotation marks omitted); see *State v. Robbins*, 2012 ME 19, ¶ 2, 37 A.3d 294 (stating that the appellant has the burden of providing an adequate record on appeal).
