MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The Board of Harbor Commissioners for Portland Harbor (Board) and Portland Pilots, Inc. (Pilots), appeal from an order of the Superior Court (Cumberland County, *L. Walker, J.*), vacating a decision of the Board and remanding the matter to the Board for further proceedings. The court found that the Board erred in failing to consider Pilots' revenues when adopting a rate increase for pilotage service in Portland Harbor.

We conclude, contrary to the Board's and Pilots' assertions, that no exception to the final judgment rule applies to this interlocutory appeal; accordingly, we dismiss the appeal and remand for further proceedings before the Board. *See State v. Carrillo*, 2018 ME 84, ¶ 4, 187 A.3d 621; *Willey v. Willey*, 2015 ME 102, ¶ 4, 121 A.3d 111; *Liberty v. Bennett*, 2012 ME 81, ¶ 18, 46 A.3d 1141; M.R. Civ. P. 80B(m).
