MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Rose M. Masse appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Portland, *Cashman, J.*) awarding parental rights and responsibilities as to Masse and Rand's minor child. Contrary to Masse's contentions, each of the court's factual findings is supported by competent record evidence, and the court did not err or abuse its discretion by awarding Rand primary residence of the child with supervised contact by Masse consistent with 19-A M.R.S. § 1653(3) (2018). *See Vibert v. Dimoulas*, 2017 ME 62, ¶¶ 15-17, 159 A.3d 325; *Handrahan v. Malenko*, 2011 ME 15, ¶ 14, 12 A.3d 79.
