MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Kelley A. O'Shea appeals from a judgment of the Superior Court (York County, O'Neil, J.) entered in favor of Kathleen M. O'Shea, Brian C. O'Shea, John J.C. O'Shea, and Killybegs, LLC, after a jury-waived trial on Kelley's complaint concerning a long-standing dispute over the management of two family trusts. Contrary to Kelley's contentions, we discern no factual or legal errors in the court's thoughtful and thorough decision. The Superior Court issued a judgment addressing the factual and procedural background and provided a comprehensive analysis of the substantive legal issues presented in this matter, and we agree in every respect with the court's analysis. See Hammer v. Sec'y of State, 2010 ME 109, ¶ 4, 8 A.3d 700 ("When a lower court produces a comprehensive, well-reasoned decision, an appellate court should refrain from writing at length to no other end than to hear its own words resonate." (quotation marks omitted)).
