## MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Jamie J. Jordan appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Newport, *Budd, J.*) entering a protection from harassment order for Pat Doe on Doe's complaint against Jordan. *See* 5 M.R.S. § 4655 (2020). Contrary to Jordan's contentions, the court did not hinder Jordan's opportunity to be heard, *see Guardianship & Conservatorship of Jones*, 2017 ME 125, ¶ 19, 164 A.3d 969 ("The essence of due process is notice and an opportunity to be heard." (quotation marks omitted)); *Daud v. Abdullahi*, 2015 ME 48, ¶ 8 n.2, 115 A.3d 77. Additionally, the court's finding that Jordan had committed acts of harassment against Doe within the meaning of 5 M.R.S. § 4651(2) (2020) was supported by competent evidence in the record. *See Allen v. Rae*, 2019 ME 53, ¶¶ 7-9, 206 A.3d 902.
