MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Lawrence C. Cushing III appeals from an amended judgment entered by the District Court (Portland, *Kelly, J.*) following a two-day trial on Corinna M. (Cushing) Roberts's complaint for divorce. As an initial matter, contrary to Cushing's procedural argument concerning his failure to file a M.R. Civ. P. 52(b) motion for further findings of fact and conclusions of law, we will, on this record, assume that the trial court made all factual findings necessary to support its judgment. *See Guardianship of David P.*, 2018 ME 151, ¶ 1, 196 A.3d 896.

Furthermore, our review of the court's thorough, supported findings reveals no abuse of discretion in its (1) division of the marital property, *see* 19-A M.R.S. § 953(1) (2018); (2) award to Roberts of transitional spousal support and general spousal support exceeding the term established by the statutory presumption, *see* 19-A M.R.S. § 951-A(2)(A)-(B), (5) (2018); or (3) award to Roberts of a portion of her attorney fees based on the parties' respective financial positions. *See Sulikowski v. Sulikowski*, 2019 ME 143, ¶ 20, 216 A.3d 893; *Mooar v. Greenleaf*, 2018 ME 23, ¶ 14, 179 A.3d 307; *Neri v. Heilig*, 2017 ME 146, ¶¶ 10 n.3, 16, 166 A.3d 1020.
