#### MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Bucksport Motel Properties, Inc., and its president, Lawrence Green (collectively, Green), appeal from a judgment of the Superior Court (Hancock County, *Anderson, J.*) denying their M.R. Civ. P. 60(b) motion for relief from the stipulated dismissal of their complaint, which purported to assert an 80B appeal plus value determination and breach of contract claims against the Town of Bucksport. *See* M.R. Civ. P. 41(a). Contrary to Green's contentions, the court was not compelled to conclude that Green established any grounds for relief pursuant to Rule 60(b)(1), (3), (6) and did not abuse its discretion in denying Green's motion. *See Haskell v. Haskell*, 2017 ME 91, ¶¶ 12-14, 160 A.3d 1176; *Ezell v. Lawless*, 2008 ME 139, ¶¶ 18-19, 955 A.2d 202.
