MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Shania T. appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Newport, *Budd, J.*) terminating her parental rights to her child. *See* 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(A)(1)(a), (B)(2)(a), (B)(2)(b)(i)-(ii), (iv) (2020). Contrary to her contentions,¹ there was sufficient evidence to support the court's finding, by clear and convincing evidence, of at least one ground of parental unfitness. *See id.* § 4055(1)(B)(2)(b)(i)-(ii), (iv); *In re Child of Christine M.*, 2018 ME 133, ¶ 6, 194 A.3d 390. We affirm the judgment.
