MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Kevin Goulet appeals from a judgment of conviction entered in the trial court (Penobscot County, *Stitham, J.*) following a bench trial. Viewing the evidence in the light most favorable to the State, we conclude that there was sufficient evidence for the trial court to rationally find beyond a reasonable doubt that Goulet was operating under the influence of intoxicants. *See* 29-A M.R.S. § 2411(1-A)(A)(1) (2020); *State v. Atkins*, 2015 ME 162, ¶ 1, 129 A.3d 952; *State v. Woodard*, 2013 ME 36, ¶ 19, 68 A.3d 1250.
