MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Paul P. appeals from a jeopardy order concerning his youngest child entered in the District Court (Fort Kent, *Soucy, J.*) on the petition of the Department of Health and Human Services. Contrary to the father's contention, there is sufficient evidence in the record to support the court's determination, by a preponderance of the evidence, that the child is in circumstances of jeopardy to his health or welfare. *See* 22 M.R.S. §§ 4002(6), 4035 (2020); *In re B.C.*, 2012 ME 140, ¶ 11, 58 A.3d 1118.
