MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Johnathon Irish appeals from a judgment of the District Court (York, *Moskowitz, J.*) granting Pat Doe's¹ motion to amend a protection from abuse order by extending the order for ten years. *See* 19-A M.R.S. § 4007(2) (2021). Contrary to Irish's contentions, no due process issues arose during the hearing because, as competent evidence in the record reflects, the court acted impartially during the hearing and gave Irish the opportunity to introduce evidence and respond to claims and evidence. *See Smith ex rel. Kate L. v. Hawthorne*, 2002 ME 149, ¶ 15, 804 A.2d 1133; *Jusseume v. Ducatt*, 2011 ME 43, ¶¶ 11-13, 15 A.3d 714. Furthermore, the District Court correctly applied the Maine Rules of Evidence. *See* M.R. Evid. 101(a)(3), (b).
