## MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Jennifer R. appeals from orders entered in the District Court (Lewiston, Oram, J.) finding that her three children would be in jeopardy if returned to her care. 22 M.R.S. § 4035 (2021). Contrary to the mother's contentions, the record contains sufficient competent evidence to support the court's findings that she poses jeopardy to the children based on her unmanaged mental health; inability to provide the children with safe housing; and history of violent relationships, which have exposed the children to domestic violence and unsafe people. Id.;  $In \ re \ Nicholas \ S.$ , 2016 ME 82,  $\P$  9, 140 A.3d 1226.
