MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Dustin Webber appeals from an amended judgment of divorce entered by the District Court (Waterville, *Dow, J.*) modifying child support.

We dismiss Dustin's appeal as interlocutory. The appeal was filed at the same time as the objection to the Family Law Magistrate's (*Chandler, M.*) amended judgment, and prior to the District Court's judgment adopting the order of the magistrate, which was not entered until three days after the notice of appeal was filed.¹ *See* M.R. Civ. P. 118; *see, e.g., Kline v. Burdin*, 2017 ME 194, ¶ 5, 170 A.3d 282. Dustin filed no notice of appeal from the court's final judgment.

The entry is:

Appeal dismissed as interlocutory.

¹ Even if we had accepted the appeal, Dustin would not have prevailed because his arguments were unpersuasive and there was no evidence whatsoever that the trial judge was not impartial.
