MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Sasha Hamlin appeals from a judgment entered in the District Court (Augusta, *Rushlau*, *J.*) denying her motion to modify a 2019 parental rights and responsibilities order and granting Gregory Voisine's motion to modify the same order. Contrary to Hamlin's contentions, the court did not commit clear error or abuse its discretion when it modified the parental rights order to provide that (1) the child will reside primarily with Voisine, (2) the parties will have shared parental rights and responsibilities, and (3) Voisine will have final decision-making authority in the event that the parties cannot agree. *See* 19-A M.R.S. §§ 1501(5), 1653(1), (3), (10), 1657 (2021); *Kelley v. McKee*, 2019 ME 155, ¶ 7, 218 A.3d 753; *Papadopoulos v. Phillips*, 2018 ME 74, ¶ 8, 186 A.3d 852; *Sloan v. Christianson*, 2012 ME 72, ¶ 33, 43 A.3d 978; *Nadeau v. Nadeau*, 2008 ME 147, ¶ 35, 957 A.2d 108.
