MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Efi Marine appeals from an order entered in the District Court (Rockland, *Mathews, J.*) on the motion of Limor Marine, finding him in contempt of the court's prior order on consolidated post-judgment motions in connection with the parties' divorce judgment. Contrary to Efi's contentions, the court committed neither clear error nor an abuse of discretion by determining that Efi violated two terms of the court's prior order.¹ See M.R. Civ. P. 66; *Pratt v. Spaulding*, 2003 ME 56, ¶¶ 13-14, 822 A.2d 1183

¹ In an order containing findings of facts and conclusions of law issued after the previous round of litigation between these parties, the court twice remarked that Efi's conduct has "significantly increased the cost of . . . litigation." Efi's decision to file this appeal demonstrates that this pattern continues unabated.
