MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Prescott McCurdy appeals from a judgment of the District Court (West Bath, *Field*, *J*.) where he was adjudicated to have committed the traffic infraction of operating while license is suspended for failure to pay license reinstatement fee, pursuant to 29-A M.R.S. § 2412-A(8)(B) (2021). Because McCurdy's arguments on appeal are underdeveloped and unsupported by any legal authority, we decline to address them. *See State v. Salisbury*, 2017 ME 215, \P 2, 173 A.3d 146. In addition, because McCurdy failed to follow the appellate rules, we dismiss his appeal. *See* M.R. App. P. 4(c), 7A(1)(e), 8(c)-(l).
