MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Ronald and Nicole S. appeal from a judgment of the District Court (Wiscasset, *Martin, J.*) terminating their parental rights to their two children. Contrary to their contentions, the record provides support for the court's findings, by clear and convincing evidence, of at least one ground of unfitness and that termination of their parental rights is in the children's best interests. *See* 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2)(a), (b)(i), (ii), (iv) (2021); *In re Cameron B.*, 2017 ME 18, ¶¶ 10, 11, 154 A.3d 1199.
