MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Elizabeth D. appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Belfast, *E. Walker, J.*) terminating her parental rights to two of her children. Contrary to the mother's contentions, the court did not err or abuse its discretion when it determined that termination of her parental rights was in the children's best interests. *See* 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2)(a) (2021); *In re Cameron B.*, 2017 ME 18, ¶¶ 10-11, 154 A.3d 1199. The court's decision is supported by competent evidence in the record. *See In re Child of Jessica C.*, 2020 ME 63, ¶¶ 6, 8, 232 A.3d 224.
