MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

David Moody appeals from a divorce judgment entered by the District Court (Biddeford, *Moskowitz, J.*) awarding Loretta Moody the marital home and ordering her to pay David one-half of the equity in the home. Contrary to David's contention, the court's express factual findings, all of which are supported by competent evidence in the record, demonstrate that it considered all relevant factors listed in 19-A M.R.S. § 953(1) (2021), and the court did not abuse its discretion in disposing of the marital home and other marital property. *See Mooar v. Greenleaf*, 2018 ME 23, ¶ 7, 179 A.3d 307; *Hutt v. Hanson*, 2016 ME 128, ¶ 12, 147 A.3d 352; *Bond v. Bond*, 2011 ME 54, ¶ 15, 17 A.3d 1219.
