MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Kenneth P. appeals from a judgment of the District Court (South Paris, *Ham-Thompson, J.*) terminating his parental rights as to his child. Contrary to the father's contention, the record contains sufficient evidence to support the court's finding of parental unfitness by clear and convincing evidence. *See* 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2)(b)(i)-(ii), (iv) (2021); *In re Child of Erica H.*, 2019 ME 66, ¶ 9, 207 A.3d 1197; *In re Olivia F.*, 2019 ME 149, ¶ 5, 217 A.3d 1106; *In re Children of Tiyonie R.*, 2019 ME 34, ¶ 6, 203 A.3d 824. Further, contrary to the father's contention, his due process rights were not violated. *See In re Child of James R.*, 2018 ME 50, ¶ 17, 182 A.3d 1252; *In re A.M.*, 2012 ME 118, ¶ 20, 55 A.3d 463.
