MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Two brothers appeal from a judgment of the Lincoln County Probate Court (*Avantaggio, J.*) denying their omnibus motion for relief in which they sought, inter alia, to have the court void a deed of distribution issued by the trustee of the protected person's trust. We affirm the Probate Court's conclusion that A. was under a limited conservatorship and retained the right to modify the schedule of remainder interests of the trust. *See* 18-A M.R.S. §§ 5-408, -420, -424, -426 (2015). We do not address the petitioners' argument regarding the application of 18-A M.R.S. § 5-422 (2015) because it was not sufficiently presented or developed in pleadings or arguments submitted to the Probate Court. *See Homeward Residential, Inc. v. Gregor*, 2017 ME 128, ¶ 9, 165 A.3d 357.
