MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Harley D. appeals from jeopardy orders concerning her children entered in the District Court (Ellsworth, *Larson, J.*) on the petitions of the Department of Health and Human Services. Contrary to the mother's contention, there is sufficient evidence in the record to support the court's determination, by a preponderance of the evidence, that the children are in circumstances of jeopardy to their health or welfare. *See* 22 M.R.S. §§ 4002(6), 4035 (2020); *In re Child of Ryan F.*, 2020 ME 21, ¶¶ 30-31, 224 A.3d 1051.
