MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Thomas C. appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Caribou, *Soucy, J.*) finding that three of his children are in jeopardy in his care. 22 M.R.S. § 4035 (2021). Contrary to the father's contentions, the record contains sufficient competent evidence to support the court's findings that he poses jeopardy to the children based on physical abuse, neglect, and abandonment. *Id.*; see *In re Child of Ryan F.*, 2020 ME 21, ¶¶ 30-31, 224 A.3d 1051.
