MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Amy V. appeals from a jeopardy order as to her two children entered in the District Court (Dover-Foxcroft, *Stitham, J.*) on the petition of the Department of Health and Human Services. Contrary to the mother's contention, there is sufficient evidence in the record to support the court's determination, by a preponderance of the evidence, that the children are in circumstances of jeopardy to their health or welfare. *See* 22 M.R.S. §§ 4002(6), 4035 (2021); *In re Child of Ryan F.*, 2020 ME 21, ¶¶ 30-32, 224 A.3d 1051.
