MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Martina M. Sullivan appeals from a judgment entered by the District Court (West Bath, *Archer*, *J*.) after a hearing on Sullivan's complaint for protection from harassment against Samuel Kilbourn. The court granted Kilbourn's motion for judgment as a matter of law. *See* M.R. Civ. P. 50(d). Contrary to Sullivan's contentions, the court was not compelled to find that Sullivan met her burden of establishing, by a preponderance of the evidence, that Kilbourn harassed her within the meaning of 5 M.R.S. § 4651(2) (2020), *see Harris Mgmt., Inc. v. Coulombe*, 2016 ME 166, ¶ 13, 151 A.3d 7, and the court did not abuse its discretion in assessing reasonable attorney fees to be paid pursuant to 5 M.R.S. § 4655(1-A) (2020), *see Doe v. McLean*, 2020 ME 40, ¶ 8, 228 A.3d 1080.¹

¹ We do not grant Kilbourn's request for an award of his attorney fees on appeal both because he did not file a separate motion for sanctions and because an award would not be merited in any event. *See* M.R. App. P. 13(f); *McGarvey v. McGarvey*, 2019 ME 40, ¶ 6, 204 A.3d 1276.
