MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

In this consolidated appeal, Gretchen S. challenges two judgments entered in the District Court (Portland, *Woodman, J.*) terminating her parental rights to her two minor children. We conclude that each of the court's factual findings supporting its determinations of parental unfitness and the best interests of the children is supported by competent record evidence, and we discern no abuse of discretion in the court's determination that termination of the mother's parental rights is in the best interests of the children. See 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2)(a), (b)(i), (ii) (2021); *In re Children of Danielle M.*, 2019 ME 174, ¶¶ 12, 14, 222 A.3d 608; *In re M.C.*, 2014 ME 128, ¶¶ 6-8, 104 A.3d 139.
