#### MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Steve Anctil appeals from a judgment of the Superior Court (Knox County, *Billings, J.*) dismissing for want of prosecution his petition seeking judicial review of an action taken by the Department of Corrections. M.R. Civ. P. 80C. Contrary to Anctil's contention, a motion filed pursuant to Rule 80C(f) does not automatically toll the briefing deadline imposed by Rule 80C(g), and on this record the court did not otherwise abuse its discretion in dismissing the petition when Anctil failed to file a brief as required by Rule 80C(g) and the court's scheduling order. M.R. Civ. P. 80C(h); *see Leadbetter Int'l Trucks, Inc. v. State Tax Assessor*, 483 A.2d 1226, 1229 (Me. 1984); *Town of Wiscasset v. Mason Station, LLC*, 2015 ME 59, ¶ 7, 116 A.3d 458; *Capelety v. Estes*, 2023 ME 50, ¶ 18, --- A.3d ---.
