MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Laurine K. appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Newport, *Faircloth, J.*) terminating her parental rights to her child. Contrary to the mother's arguments, we discern no error in the court's termination of the mother's parental rights. *See In re Children of Jason C.*, 2020 ME 86, ¶¶ 7-8, 10-12, 236 A.3d 438. There is sufficient evidence in the record to support the court's findings regarding parental unfitness, the record evidence also supports the court's findings regarding the child's best interest, and the court did not abuse its discretion in concluding that termination of the mother's parental rights was in the child's best interest. *See, e.g.*, 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2)(a), (b)(i)-(ii) (2023); 22 M.R.S. § 4050 (2023); *In re Child of Louise G.*, 2020 ME 87, ¶¶ 6, 8-11, 236 A.3d 445; *In re Children of Jessica D.*, 2019 ME 70, ¶¶ 3-5, 8-9, 208 A.3d 363; *In re Children of Anthony M.*, 2018 ME 146, ¶¶ 6-15, 195 A.3d 1229; *In re K.M.*, 2015 ME 79, ¶¶ 9-11, 118 A.3d 812.
