MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Jeremy B. appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Rumford, *Churchill, J.*) terminating his parental rights to his child pursuant to 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2)(a)-(b) (2023). The court did not err or abuse its discretion in finding at least one ground of parental unfitness and determining that termination of the father's parental rights was in the child's best interests. *Id.*; *In re Child of Louise G.*, 2020 ME 87, ¶ 8, 236 A.3d 445; *In Re R.M.*, 2015 ME 38, ¶ 7, 114 A.3d 212; *In re Myra B.*, 2017 ME 174, ¶ 4, 168 A.3d 820; *In re Children of Travis G.*, 2019 ME 20, ¶ 6, 201 A.3d 1224.
