MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Roger Bower Jr. appeals from the District Court's (Skowhegan, *Benson, J.*) grant of Doe's request of a final order for protection from abuse. Bower contends that the court erred when it allowed testimony of events not specifically pleaded in Doe's complaint.

Prior to the hearing Bower was given notice of the witness's testimony; however, he never objected to the testimony nor requested a continuance. Bower waived the issue of whether Doe's complaint complied with due process and whether Doe's complaint gave him notice of the allegations against him. See Brown v. Town of Starks, 2015 ME 47, \P 6, 114 A.3d 1003; Mitchell v. Flynn, 460 A.2d 1375, 1377-78 (Me. 1983).
