MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Sarah Chagnon timely appeals from a judgment of the Superior Court (York County, *Mulhern, J.*) dismissing her complaint for civil perjury and conspiracy to defraud. *See* 14 M.R.S. § 1851 (2023); M.R. App. P. 2B(c)(1). Contrary to Chagnon's contentions, the trial court did not err in dismissing her complaint for civil perjury because it correctly determined that the police and EMS reports were not newly discovered evidence. *See Nadeau v. Frydrych*, 2014 ME 154, ¶ 5, 108 A.3d 1254; 14 M.R.S. § 870 (2023); *Bean v. Cummings*, 2008 ME 18, ¶ 9, 939 A.2d 676.
