MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Juan Espinal appeals from a judgment of conviction for aggravated trafficking of scheduled drugs (Class A), 17-A M.R.S. § 1105-A(1)(M) (2023), and unlawful trafficking in scheduled drugs (Class B), 17-A M.R.S. § 1103(1-A)(A) (2023), entered by the trial court (Somerset County, *Mullen, C.J.*) following a jury trial. Contrary to Espinal's contention, from the evidence admitted at trial the jury could rationally find beyond a reasonable doubt that he constructively possessed the drugs seized from the apartment where he was staying, and could ultimately find every element of the offenses charged. *See State v. Anderson*, 2016 ME 183, ¶¶ 25-26, 30-32, 152 A.3d 623.

The court also entered judgment against Espinal on one count of criminal forfeiture, 15 M.R.S. § 5826 (2023), concerning \$719 found in his wallet.¹ Although we are satisfied as to the court's intent based on its statement when imposing sentence, we note that the record does not contain a final order of

disposition as required by 15 M.R.S. § 5826(6).² In the interest of judicial economy, we affirm the judgment and remand in order that the court may issue an appropriate order and make a corresponding entry on the docket.

The entry is:

Judgment affirmed. Remanded for the trial court to issue an order complying with 15 M.R.S. § 5826(6) concerning Count 3 and to note the order on the court's docket.
