A. appeals from the District Court's (Newport, *Ociepka, J.*) entry of a judgment extending weapons restrictions for one year under 34-B M.R.S. § 3862-A(6)(D) (2023). Contrary to A.'s contentions, there is competent evidence in the record to support the court's finding by clear and convincing evidence that he presented a likelihood of foreseeable harm. *See id.* § 3862-A(1)(A), (G), (6)(B), (C); *In re J.*, 2022 ME 34, ¶ 28, 276 A.3d 510; *In re Estate of Fournier*, 2009 ME 17, ¶ 14, 966 A.2d 885.
