MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

George J. Stanley appeals from an adjudication by the District Court (Lewiston, *Powers, A.R.J.*) determining that he committed the traffic infraction of operating a motor vehicle with an obstructed view. *See* 29-A M.R.S. § 2082(2) (2025). Because Stanley did not include a transcript of the hearing on appeal, “we must assume that the transcript would support the trial court’s findings of fact and its rulings on evidence and procedure.” *State v. Nugent*, 2002 ME 111, ¶ 2, 801 A.2d 1001. Accordingly, despite Stanley’s contention that there was not sufficient evidence to support the court’s finding, we affirm the adjudication.
