MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Judith Seider appeals from the judgment of the Administrative Court (*Wheeler, J.*) denying her petition for review of the Board of Examiners of Psychologists' decision concluding that Seider violated certain ethical principles of the Board. Contrary to Seider's contentions, the record contains sufficient evidence to support the Board's conclusion that Seider violated Ethical Principles 5(a) and 6(a). *See Mattress v. Land Use Regulation Comm'n*, 600 A.2d 391, 394 (Me. 1991).
