MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Claire J. Choquette appeals from the judgment entered in the Superior Court (Androscoggin County, *Cole, J.*) affirming the divorce judgment entered in the District Court (Lewiston, *Beliveau, J.*). Contrary to Ms. Choquette's contentions, although the court misnamed certain property as marital or nonmarital, the property was set aside or awarded to the appropriate party, and the trial court's decree violates no positive rule of law, nor does it result in a plain and unmistakable injustice, so apparent that it is instantly visible without argument. *See Kapler v. Kapler*, 2000 ME 131, ¶ 8, 755 A.2d 502, 506 (quoting *Robinson v. Robinson*, 2000 ME 101, ¶ 9, 751 A.2d 457, 459).
