MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Timothy Mooney appeals from the judgment entered in the Superior Court (Cumberland County, *Humphrey, J.*) on a jury verdict finding him guilty of murder. *See* 17-A M.R.S.A. § 201(1)(A) & (B) (1983). Contrary to Mooney's contentions, the motion court did not err in concluding that the police had probable cause to arrest him, *see State v. Boylan*, 665 A.2d 1016, 1019 (Me. 1995), or in concluding that his statements were voluntary, *see State v. Butler*, 674 A.2d 925, 927 (Me. 1996). Additionally, the trial court did not err in instructing the jury on accomplice liability. *See State v. Caouette*, 462 A.2d 1171, 1175 (Me. 1983).
