MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Darren Hall appeals from a judgment of conviction entered after a jury verdict of guilty in the Superior Court (Knox County, *Atwood, J.*) for criminal OUI in violation of 29-A M.R.S.A. § 2411 (1996 & Supp. 1999). Contrary to Hall's contentions, the trial court did not abuse its discretion or commit obvious error in admitting statements made by him to officers of the Camden Police Department.
