## MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

James E. Storey appeals from the judgment entered by the Superior Court (Washington County, *Atwood, J.*) following a jury verdict finding him guilty of eluding an officer (Class C) in violation of 29-A M.R.S.A. § 2414(3) (1996), and endangering the welfare of a child (Class D) in violation of 17-A M.R.S.A. § 554 (1983 & Supp. 1999). Contrary to Storey's contentions, viewed in the light most favorable to the State, the evidence supports the jury's verdicts of guilty on both charges. *See State v. Wilder*, 2000 ME 32, ¶ 46, 748 A.2d 444, 455.
