MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Kenneth Bustin appeals from a judgment of foreclosure entered in the District Court (Farmington, *Mullen, J*). Contrary to the contentions of Bustin, his appeal to this Court was not timely filed, *see Green Tree Fin. Corp. v. Patten,* 2000 ME 42, ¶¶ 14, 16, 746 A.2d 373, 376-77; M.R. Civ. P. 73(b), and he was not denied due process of law by the manner in which he was notified of the motion for summary judgment, the hearing on that motion, and the judgment of foreclosure, *see* M.R. Civ. P. 5(b); *Kingsbury v. Forbes,* 1998 ME 168, ¶ 7, 714 A.2d 149, 151, nor was he denied due process by the failure of the court to address his motion for a more definite statement when he had already filed an answer to a complaint that set out all the facts necessary to support its allegations, *see* 1 Field, McKusick & Wroth, *Maine Civil Practice,* § 12.16 at 255 (2d ed. 1970).
