MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Gerry Hill Well Drilling, Inc. (Hill), appeals from a judgment of the Superior Court (Knox County, *Marsano, J.*) dismissing Hill's appeal from a small claims judgment entered by the District Court (Rockland, *Anderson, J.*) in favor of plaintiff William Stevens. As Hill acknowledges, its defective affidavits were insufficient to show a jury issue. *See* M.R.S.C.P. 11(d)(2); M.R. Civ. P. 80L(c). The Superior Court was not required to mine the record on its own in search of a jury issue.
